



# Edleston Primary Parent Survey Nov 2016 – Jan 2017 – The Full Results for GB

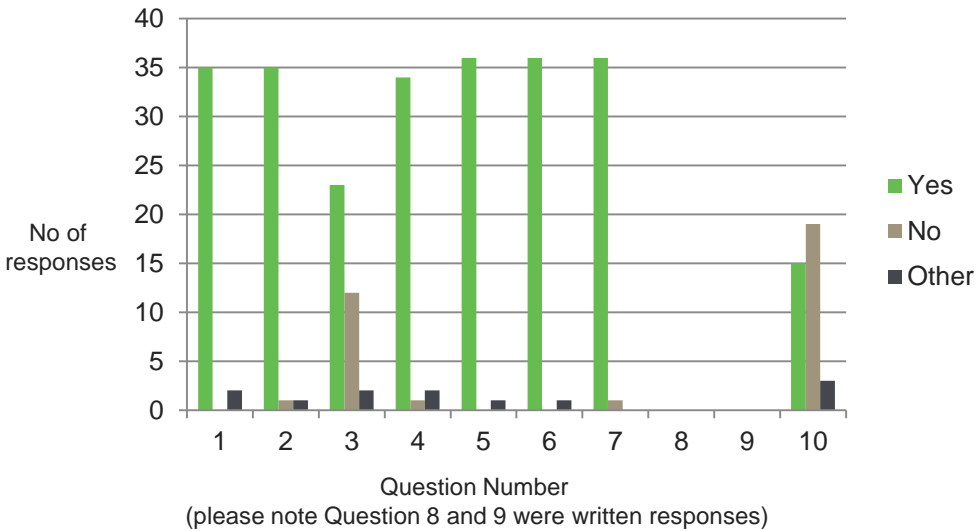

## **We've heard your suggestions/comments, So what have we done?**

### **New School App/Website -**

This reduces the number of texts that comes through in one go.

School can send messages via the app.

All school dates and information is contained on the app.

Weekly Blogs from the teachers to keep you up to date with what the class is learning/focusing on that week.

### **Theatre Trip 2017 –**

The school have sent out details on a local trip to Crewe Lyceum v's the Newcastle under Lyme trip that has been taking place recently. Parents are encouraged to reply on which they feel would be better for the children. **We had 1 written response by the required deadline.**

### **Parking in Front of the School –**

Emma Humphries and Andrew Flood (Chair and Vice Chair of Governing Body) gave an interview with the Crewe Chronicle to highlight the dangers of parking on the zig zag lines. The article was published on line and in print.

School send out reminder texts to all parents that have registered a mobile number with the school.

### **PTA Events -**

Mrs Thomasson (PTA Chair) runs regular meetings where all parents are invited, at these meetings future events are discussed and planned. If you are not yet on the Edleston PTA Facebook group please go to the Reception Classroom either before 9am or after 3.10pm.

Recently the money raised by the PTA was shared out amongst all classes, they each have £70 to spend on whatever they decide.

### **Behaviour Rewards -**

Children are given dojos as behaviour rewards.

Children are given negative dojos if they do not follow the school rules. These are given discretely so often other children in the class do not know about these.

Occasionally school organises activities for individual children who need extra support to access the curriculum. The reason for these is to teach the child respect for others and how to work as a team. Although they may seem as a reward to other children they are to help these children to follow the school rules. Teachers differentiate the curriculum for individual children and they also have to differentiate the reward system for individual children.

### **Coffee Mornings/Afternoons –**

We would like to invite Parents/Guardians to our Coffee Morning on 13/3/17 at 9am where Governors and the Leadership team will be on hand to discuss anything school related.

**Curriculum Workshops** –we held curriculum meetings for all parents at the beginning of the school year.

Every Monday we send a news feed so you know what your child will be doing during the week.

On each class website page you can see what maths and literacy work your child will be learning over the year. This page also includes the common exception words your child needs to be able to spell and the KIRFS for each term.

Under the parents curriculum information section you can find out about what sentence structures we teach in each year group and about the SPaG they will be learning. Everything you need to know about what your child will be taught in each year group is on our website. If you need any help to find anything please pop in and see us.
