Dear Parents/Carers,

From September there will be a few changes in school. Please keep these changes in mind;

- **4th September 2018.** All charged school meals will increase to **£2.30** a day or £11.50 a week.
- **4th September 2018.** All snack products will increase from 25p – **30p** per item. (Friday's bacon bap/pizza bap will remain at the same price).
- **School PE kit.** If your child requires a new PE kit for the new term please do not buy a white t-shirt please buy a **PLAIN** t-shirt in the colour of your child's house. (This is the same as Town Sports). We are currently looking into a provider who stocks all the 6 house colours of our school. If you shop on e-Bay, Fruit of the Loom coloured t-shirts are less than £3 with free delivery. Please check with your child's class teacher if you are unsure of the house colour. Blue sports shorts and black pumps remain unchanged.
- **School Uniform.** We are looking at changing provider and offering uniform on sale online including the coloured PE t-shirts resulting in limited stock in school.



A reminder in the warmer weather girls may wear a blue/white gingham checked dress with black or white sandals. Jelly shoes/crocs are not suitable or appropriate. Boys may wear black shorts with their school shoes or appropriate sandals in black. White polo shirts and grey shorts/trousers are not part of our uniform policy and are no longer permitted.
